Repair Affair volunteers succeed in every kind of job! Team leaders determine the tasks, order materials and oversee the jobs. Team members tackle anything from painting to carpentry. Runners ensure that materials are where they need to be! Team support volunteers prepare meals, prepare thank you cards or help volunteers in any way that helps us accomplish team goals.

Repairs are made by volunteer teams in one day. Homes are selected by each team based on their skills.

Who does Repair Affair help?

Repair Affair homeowners live in almost every neighborhood. And, thanks to caring volunteers, 2005 Repair Affair's impact spanned the community. In Jefferson County, applications were taken from 22 of the 26 Metro council districts—and homes in 18 districts were aided. In Southern Indiana, 55 applications resulted in 29 homes helped in New Albany and Floyd County. 21 homes in Jeffersonville and Clark County were also helped.

To be eligible for Repair Affair, a recipient must:

- Own and reside in the home
- Be at least 60 years old or certified as disabled
- Be of low income, 50% of area median income or less

Repairs are completed from March to November, with most teams working on two exciting event days in mid June!

Mobilizes resources and volunteers to make home repairs on homes owned by elderly or disabled, low-income homeowners.

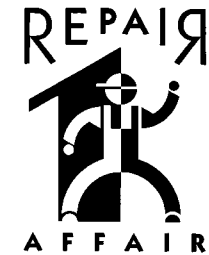
Repair Affair celebrated its 10th year in Southern Indiana and its 12th year in Jefferson County.
